



OUR HISTORY

The Robin Hood (AND) Little John dates back to 1765 and is believed to be the oldest pub in Arnold. Originally a small coaching inn, travellers would rest their horses at The Robin Hood (AND) Little John before making the climb of Red Hill—now more commonly known as the A60 Mansfield Road.

The lettable rooms were located on the third floor of the pub, now long since disused. The Stables block is situated opposite our Skittle Alley and originally had stalls for up to four horses. Over the years, the stalls were removed and the building was split in half to create a garage and a store room. Evidence of the stalls within The Stables can still be seen with the outline of feeding troughs and the holes in the walls which housed the timber frame making up the enclosure.





The Stables is a unique function room which can be used for a variety of small gatherings.

We can comfortably seat up to 15 people, and a couple more if you don't mind being friendly!

It's a rough and ready space, with painted concrete floors and bare walls to show off the history of the stalls. Our fixed seating provides a place on which to perch and survey the room and view to the courtyard through our stable door.

There are no windows to the room—save the two small panes within the upper section of the door.

Heating can be provided, but we find it gets warm enough when there are a few bodies inside.

Our bar can be stocked with a drinks selection to suit your needs with plenty of cask ales, draught lagers, ciders and stouts, wines and spirits to choose from.

OUR ROOM SET UP

PAY AS YOU GO

Our standard room hire at The Stables is simple— you hire our space and pay for drinks as you go at the bar. The cost of the room is just £18 per hour— this covers the cost of the room set up and staffing of the bar.

How does it work?

Example:

Room booked 6pm—11pm (5 hours)

Room cost: £50

Staff cost: £40


Total Cost £90


Choose which drinks you'd like to have on the bar and we'll set them up ready, then just pay at your very own bar in The Stables as and when you're ready.

Ask about available real ales.

Draught—choose from Amstel, Kronenbourg, Titanic Stout and Symonds Cider.

Wines, spirits and bottles—ask about our extensive range.

Simply let us know what you want us to stock the room with and the stock is then yours to enjoy—pull your own pints, serve your own draught and enjoy, safe in the knowledge that it's already bought and paid for.

How does it work?

Select your drinks from our extensive range.

We'll agree a price for this stock which will vary based on what you choose.

Room Rate: £10 per hour.

No staffing costs— simply serve yourself!

Please note, we're legally obliged to ensure that you drink responsibly while on the premises, so we'll check in with you from time to time throughout the event.

Is gin your thing? Do you think whiskey is liquid sunshine? Isn't wine wonderful?


We think so too.

We're happy to support local microbreweries. The Stables is available for any small brewer to borrow to showcase their ales.


Do you know of a local brewery who'd like to use the space as their own pub? All they need to do is supply the staff and the beer and the sales belong to them.

LARGER EVENTS

The Stables isn't just limited to small events—if you've something bigger in mind, why not talk to us about expanding into our courtyard and skittle alley areas too?

With the combined space The Stables can comfortably accommodate a party of around 50 guests, even more if the weather is on our side.

The skittle alley is open sided and has internal heat lamps for comfort. We are able to provide tables and chairs or lay the room out for a game of skittles.

The skittle alley and The Stables also provide much needed shelter from the English weather whilst the courtyard is a sun trap in the afternoons, when the sun makes an appearance!

Hang bunting, create table decorations and personalise our space to make your event truly special.

Please note that children are permitted on the premises until 9pm. We cannot serve alcohol to under 18's and operate a 'Challenge 25' policy.







Lincoln Green Brewing Company was established in 2012 by husband and wife team Anthony and Lynette Hughes.

The brewery produces four regular, seasonal and monthly special ales that have gained a reputation for quality and consistency, winning numerous awards. Lincoln Green takes its name from the colour of dyed woollen cloth associated with the legend of Robin Hood.

Proud to be brewing in Hucknall, the company aims to operate in an environmentally aware manner, with a controlled delivery radius and sourcing goods and services from local businesses whenever possible.

The Robin Hood (AND) Little John was the first Lincoln Green public house and opened in August 2014. The Sir John Borlase Warren at Canning Circus, Nottingham followed in May 2015, whilst The Station Hotel in Hucknall and The Poet & Castle in Codnor opened in 2017.

We believe in 'proper pubs'.


